


Zagreb to Split

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 : Zagreb

Wednesday. Upon arrival at Zagreb international airport transfer to hotel in Zagreb. Remainder of the day at leisure. **Overnight – Zagreb (D)**

Day 2 : Zagreb City Tour

This morning we have a guided tour of Zagreb including the historic Upper Town, St Mark's Church, the Cathedral, the Government Palace and the Lotrščak tower. **Overnight – Zagreb (B)**

Day 3 : Plitvice Lakes

Zagreb – Plitvice Lakes – Split. From Zagreb we journey to spectacular Plitvice Lakes National Park, consisting of 16 lakes all connected by a series of waterfalls. We take a 3 hour walk and boat ride on Kozjak Lake before taking a street train back to the entrance. We continue to Split for the evening. **Overnight – Split (B)**

Day 4 : Split

Saturday. We enjoy a guided tour of Split this morning before hotel check out(B)

Visas and passports

Essential packing

Please check local temperatures so you can pack accordingly. Visit www.worldclimate.com

- Lightweight cotton garments in summer, warm clothing for Spring and Autumn (temperatures can get quite low at night)
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Universal travel adaptor
- DEET based mosquito repellent and antihistamine cream
- First aid kit including Dioralyte
- Tour Voucher and a copy of your travel insurance policy, spare passport photos and a photocopy of your passport
- Sunglasses, hat, sunscreen, swim costume, torch and money belt
- Either a rucksack or suitcase is suitable. A small daypack for your day-to-day needs
- A towel for swimming/showering (unless stated as included under the Trip Notes 'Inclusions' section on page one of these Trip Notes)

Health requirements and water

The tap water in Croatia is generally considered safe to drink, but as a precaution against stomach upsets you may want to drink bottled mineral water, which is readily available from shops, hotels and restaurants.
