DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 : Luang Prabang

Welcome to Laos. Upon arrival at Luang Prabang airport you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. **Overnight - Luang Prabang**

Day 2 : City tour & Khouang Si waterfall



This morning take in the highlights of enchanting Luang Prabang on a city tour. Visit the impressive stupa of Wat Visoun, the former Royal Palace which is now a National Museum and the sobering UXO Centre, where you will learn about Laos' Hidden War. In the afternoon travel to the beautiful Khouang Si waterfall, where you can swim in the turquoise pools, and visit the Sun Bear Reserve, a conservation centre that rescues animals from the wildlife trade. This evening explore the Luang Prabang Night Market before dinner at a local home, accompanied

Day 3 : Free day in Luang Prabang



Today is free for you to spend at leisure in Luang Prabang or choose one of the optional excursions

Alternatively there is an optional excursion to the Pak Ou Caves on a Mekong boat trip. Within the caves are thousands of tiny gilded statues of Buddha that were left by pilgrims and worshipped for centuries. Then stop at the village of Ban Xangkhong, known for its hand woven silk and traditional Saa Paper making. Alternatively, visit a local farm in Luang Prabang, to learn about the production of rice, using water buffalo for and other traditional processes. **Overnight - Luang Prabang** (B)

Day 4 : Vientiane - Laos Cuisine

Today's unique experience is a "Monks life encounter". Buddhism is the basis of Laos culture and temples play an important role in Laotian daily life. The daily alms-giving ritual is a must-see for any visitor to Luang Prabang, a "Monks life encounter" offers the opportunity to participate in this practice in an authentic manner at a local temple. We will experience how typical Laos dishes like Laap Laos, Olam soup and papaya salad are cooked and then offer food to a local temple. We will receive a blessing where the monks chant for us as a part of this traditional ritual and later, join an open talk on Buddhism in Laos with monks, or enjoy lunch with the food you just cooked, according to your preference.

This afternoon we visit Wat Xieng Thong, dating back to the 16th century, it is considered the most beautiful temple in Luang Prabang. Our final stop of the day is at the Traditional Arts and Ethnology Centre, giving us an insight into Laos' ethnic minority groups. Early this evening board the train in Luang Prabang for a 2-hour rail journey to Vientiane. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Overnight - Vientiane (B, L)

Day 5 : Vientiane - City Tour



Today visit the COPE educational centre, a compelling centre that teaches us about Laos' Hidden War and the aid that is being given to help civilian victims of conflict. Afterwards we continue on to the unique Buddha Park or Xiang Khouan as it's known locally, the park is filled with hundreds of Buddhist and Hindu statues creating a peaceful atmosphere.

Later, take a tour of Vientiane visiting Wat Sisaket, one of the oldest temples and home to thousands of miniature Buddha statues, and also visiting the former royal temple of Wat Prakeo. En route to Lao's national icon, That Luang Stupa, we pass the Patuxay Monument, known as Vientiane's own Arc de Triomphe. **Overnight - Vientiane** (B)

Day 6 : Khong Island



Today fly to Pakse, the laid back provincial capital of Champasack and drive to the ancient temple of Wat Phou, one of the oldest archaeological sites in Laos. Then enjoy the beautiful lush scenery as you take a small boat across the Mekong to Khong Island. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure exploring this sedate and picturesque island and its villages on foot or by bike. **Overnight - Don Khong Island** (B)

Day 7 : 4000 Islands Boat Trip



Set sail this morning on a scenic 4000 Islands boat trip, where you may spot the rare Irrawaddy Mekong Dolphin! After our boat ride we visit the famous waterfalls of Khone Phapeng, the largest waterfalls in South East Asia and also known as the Niagara of the east. **Overnight - Pakse** (B)

Day 8 : Pakse

Explore Pakse town your own way. Arrangements come to an end after breakfast and onward departure transfer to the airport.(B)

What to pack

Please check local temperatures so you can pack accordingly. Visit www.worldclimate.com to get an idea of what the weather will be like on your holiday.

- Lightweight cotton garments. Ladies may need to have their shoulders and legs (to below the knee) covered when visiting certain sites, so please pack accordingly
